Dear Praying Friends,

Have you ever expected to go somewhere with room enough for everything you need, only to have the space allowed cut in half? Well the McGeorge family is there! We had planned to take a 40ft container to the field with all our stuff in it until we found out that the port in Nauru does not accept 40ft containers. So now we are shipping a 20ft container from the USA and a 20ft container from Australia. Praise the Lord we're going to Nauru...but boy do we have a whole lot of stuff to do between now and then! Our container is going to be loaded mid-March, and Lord willing, we're going to fly out the 31st of March; a day or two short of the 2yr mark on full time deputation!

It was great to be home a while over these last few months. We had a meeting in Kentucky in December before having our last big family Christmas here in Indiana for a few years. January came and we headed south to Louisiana for a missions conference. Then we were at the Home Missions Conference at HBBC for a few days. After that, we headed up to Kansas City for a Missions Conference at a church where I was a summer intern before my senior year in Bible College. It was great to see so many familiar faces, and introduce my wife and son to the congregation.

When we leave here in March we'll spend 8 weeks in Australia visiting friends, family (only my mum and dad have seen my almost two year old son!), and a few churches. Then the Lord willing we should arrive in Nauru sometime late May/early June before our container from the US arrives (it takes 80 days to get there!). Praise the Lord for the house he has provided for us to live in! He certainly is better to us than we deserve!

Thank you again to those who have helped us with our needs list that we sent out a while back. We're trusting the Lord will continue to provide for us as we take the Gospel to the Central Pacific.

Some things you could pray with us about:

1. Adam's Green card renewal to process problem free
2. The Lord's continued safety and blessing during deputation travels
3. The Lord to continue to meet our moving needs and expenses
4. Financial support to come in quickly, so we can get to Nauru ASAP!
