Dear Praying Friends,

Have you ever flown with so much luggage that no matter who was meeting you at the airport there was no way it was all going to fit? We definitely felt that way with our flight from Indianapolis to Brisbane, Australia. We bought missionary fare tickets and were allowed three 70lb checked pieces of luggage for a total of 9 (YES 9!), plus carry on luggage. You can imagine our dilemma! But Praise the Lord our checked luggage didn't make all the connecting flights, so Qantas gave us \$300 to buy any essentials and when our luggage arrived the day after we landed and they were delivered to my parent's house! The Lord sure takes better care of us than we deserve.

I'd like to say a big Aussie g'day from Down Under, it's great to be back on Aussie soil for a while before heading to Nauru. We have been able to catch up with family and friends, and even visit some Aussie churches.

We flew to Perth for a few weeks and we're in four churches, ranging from a few months old to going on 50 years old. We then flew to Sydney and saw my grandparents, who met Elijah for the 1st time, their 5th great-grandchild. We drove to Nowra and Wagga to see family before driving back to the Gold Coast to help my mum and dad move. We have been in 4 churches in Queensland, with a few more scheduled for June.

Our container arrived from the US to the Port of Brisbane May 5th and is waiting to board the vessel to Nauru. Our plan was to fly to Nauru Mid June, but we are getting the run-around from the shipping company who is yet to confirm a definite ship date for our containers. The latest ship date is now to early July, which is frustrating for us as we are anxious to get to Nauru and get busy, but we know it is all in the Lord's time.

Praise the Lord my US greencard has finally processed, thanks to those who prayed to that end, I appreciate it.

Some things you could pray with us about:

1. A house to live in on south end of Nauru
2. The Lord to continue to meet our moving needs and expenses
3. The Lord to add to our prayer and financial support as we go to Nauru

We are excited about what we can accomplish together.
