Dear Praying Friends,

The International Baptist Church of Nauru had its first service on the 4th of January 2009. We had 4 in attendance from 3 different nationalities! For our first service our shade sail hadn't arrived, so we sang and I preached in the sun...boy was the preaching HOT! ☺ We had our 10mx10m shade sail up for our second Sunday which made a great difference. We had 4 again our second Sunday. The third Sunday we had 7, two of which we're adult visitors, the fourth Sunday we had 8, 5 of which were children. I've been preaching through the Gospel of John while Christie teaches Sunday school to any children 2-12. Our PNG brother, Thomas, has come to every service, and our neighbor girl, Nelly, as come a few times and brought her sister and cousins. Our other visitors were Ivan, a Nauruan man who lives 2 houses up from us and Peggy an Australian lady who is working for the Nauruan mining company. **Please pray that those who attend will come again and see their need to be saved.**

We've finished visiting our immediate neighborhood and are excited at the prospect of knocking on every door in Nauru. All of our visitors have come from door knocking and inviting them personally to attend. We leave tracts on doors when no one answers, but have not had any visit because of a tract yet. **Please pray we'd find people home when we visit and that the Lord would continue to send visitors our way.**

I've been playing some basketball with the guys in the evening which has been good exercise and an opportunity to develop relationships with them and give them a tract. I'm the token white guy on the court, and at 6'3" some the guys call me "Giant". **Please pray the Lord would show these young men their need of a Saviour.**

We continue our struggle with the Nauruan language. There is no official way to learn to speak Nauruan available. The more time I spend with the people the more words I start to recognize, but it's likely to take several years to learn. **Please pray the Lord will help us in this endeavor.**

Some other things you could pray with us about:

1. The Lord to continue to meet our moving needs and expenses.
2. The Lord to add to our prayer and financial support as we serve Him in Nauru.
