Dear Praying Friends,

The Lord has truly blessed the work here in Nauru beyond the expectations of this missionary. At the end of 3 months of ministry we had an **average March attendance of 24**, after averaging 9.5 in February and 5.75 in January. **Our two highest attendances so far were on March 15 and 22 when we had 30 and 32!** The week of the 15th, I specifically remember talking to Christie about the hope of breaking 20, as we had 18 in attendance on the 8th. The Lord truly does exceeding abundantly above all that which we ask or think. (Eph 3:20)

On March 11th we also had our first soul saved. James, a man who lives on our street, had come to church a few times and when I was talking with him he had questions about eternal security. He'd made a profession of faith in a charismatic church on the island, but had been out of church for quite a while before I invited him to come to our services. I asked, and he said he would be interested in doing some Bible study so he could get answers to his questions from the Bible. During our first meeting he expressed some doubt about his first profession of faith in Christ, as he went forward because "everyone else was" and was not aware of or convicted of sin and his need of salvation. After going through the relevant Bible verses about salvation, James trusted Christ as his Saviour. **Please Pray James will continue to grow in grace through the discipleship studies and that his family will attend church with him. 3 of the 5 children have been before, but his wife, Elizabeth, hasn't come yet as she is Catholic.**

Another visitor who has been several weeks in a row now is Darcy and his family. He's been saved and baptized, but out of church for several months till he visited our services in March. He also lives on our street and now comes with his wife and several of their grandchildren. He has expressed some interest in the discipleship lessons, **please pray that he'll learn and grow spiritually through the experience.**

Nelly, our young neighbour girl, comes faithfully with her 3 sisters. Her parents Joe and Roma have come a few times now also. Often the whole family will go to early catholic mass before coming to our services at 11am. **Please pray for the salvation of this family.**

On a personal note, my mum and dad were able to visit for almost two weeks in March for Elijah's 3rd birthday. They were a blessing to have. Dad and I made some benches to give us some more sitting room for church and mum was always busy outside in the yard.
