Dear Praying Friends,

We Praise the Lord as he continues to bless the work in Nauru. In the month of August we averaged 20.4 and had 7 visitors and 2 people saved. September we averaged 27.75 with 10 visitors and we Baptized two!!!

It was an exciting day in my life and ministry to baptize some of our first converts in Nauru, "the first fruits" if you will. After the service on September 13<sup>th</sup> we loaded up in the wagon and drove to a spot on the reef that is deep enough to immerse at high or low tide, possibly made by a WW2 bomb I am told! Anne, who I mentioned in our last letter, has been growing in faithfulness and enjoying the discipleship material greatly, was the first to be immersed, then James, who was the first man to trust the Lord, followed her. Both brought family members to witness the occasion and it was a great opportunity to preach the gospel. Some of their family members have become regular attendees too which is great.

In August I received some interesting news from the Nauru Immigration Department. We have been renewing visitor visas since our arrival in August of 2008, and were just told that on the visitor visas we are not to be inviting others to church at our house, as this violates the "normal religious observance", and therefore the conditions of the visitor visa. So we've applied for a business visa for me as a consultant in a friends business on Nauru, and dependent visas for Christie and Elijah. I'd hoped to have all the necessary things in hand before I flew out on the 28<sup>th</sup> of September, but noting happens so fast on Nauru...especially things concerning government. **Please pray that it will all go though fine and that all will be in order when we return to Nauru the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 2010, Lord willing.**

I write this letter from our home church in New Castle, Indiana, and am glad to be re-united with my wife and son after 4 ½ months. Robert and Linda Howard arrived Friday September 25<sup>th</sup> and I flew out Monday the 28<sup>th</sup> after packing a lot of information into 72 hours on Nauru. They were the Missionaries that I was saved under in Australia, where they served 15yrs. Bro. Howard currently pastors the Claremore Baptist Temple in Claremore, Oklahoma, their son Thomas is taking care of the work there in their absence. We're thankful that the Lord enabled them to come minister in Nauru in our absence and for the churches who gave to help take care of their airfares to and from Nauru.

Christie is 36 weeks pregnant with Titus and is due the 14<sup>th</sup> of November. We plan on flying to Australia the 27<sup>th</sup> of December, and back to Nauru the 4<sup>th</sup> of January, then the Howards will make their journey back the 11<sup>th</sup> of January.

Some Prayer Requests to remember..

1. A simple and healthy delivery of baby Titus in November
2. The work in Nauru to continue and grow under the Howards
3. The business visa paperwork to be approved
