Dear Praying Friends,

We Praise the Lord; it sure is great to be back in Nauru!!!☺

We enjoyed the Christmas season with family in the US and Australia. We flew out of the US on the 27th and spent 9 days in Australia with my family before getting back to Nauru the 9th of January. We did not enjoy the goodbyes, and neither did any of the grandparents, but we are glad to be back in Nauru to continue in the work of the Lord.

The work in Nauru averaged 26.75 in December and 35.8 in January!!! We broke our high attendance record 2 weeks in a row, when we had 39 for the Howard's last Sunday, and 42 the following week!!! Our people really enjoyed the Howard's ministry and they showered them with gifts to remember their time on Nauru. I was blessed and very proud of the love and appreciation that our people showed towards them. **Rajen, Anne's husband, came to church for the 1st time** for their send-off service, and Elizabeth, James's wife continues to come to services. **Please Pray these two will see their need of salvation.**

We Praise the Lord also, because now we have valid visas for 12 months!!! Our paperwork was not ready upon our arrival so the immigration authorities let us land in Nauru without any visas (usually reserved for VIP's ☺), so we could get things sorted out from this end. **We are thankful for the Lord's answer to prayer and those who prayed for our visa situation.**

On a personal note, **I became a US citizen the 17th of December 2009.** My interview went well and not long after I took the oath we drove to Chicago to get my US passport before leaving the country. **I'm thankful to the Lord and those who prayed for all my citizenship paperwork to go through well (and quick!!!) in my short trip back to the States, it was an unexpected, yet very profitable trip.** Titus continues to grow like a weed; he's just over 2 months old now and almost 18lb!!!☺. ➤

Robert and Linda Howard left Nauru the 11th of Jan to head back to Oklahoma. For the last few weeks prior to leaving Linda had severe back pain and was on pain medicine. She received medical treatment here, and back in Oklahoma, the doctors hope that some physical therapy will help the situation. **Please pray for her and the resolution of this issue.** The Howard's enjoyed their time on Nauru, but were glad to get back to Oklahoma and their grandkids. **Our family, church family, and home church are thankful for their willingness to come serve in Nauru during our brief medical furlough, and for willingness of the congregation of Claremore Baptist Temple in lending their pastor and pastor's wife to service on Nauru.**
