We trust this letter finds you busy in your service of the Lord and thankful for His many blessings. The Lord continues to bless our ministry and family in Nauru greater than we deserve. In October we averaged 23.2 with two 1<sup>st</sup> time visitors & 6.25avg for Bible Study, and in November we averaged 33.75 with **twelve 1<sup>st</sup> time visitors** & 5.5avg for Bible Study.

Last letter we were waiting for construction to begin, this letter we are blessed to have had services under our building now for 7 Sundays!!! The construction began early in October, and we had our 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday Service under our Tabernacle October 17<sup>th</sup>.

In October we had our 2<sup>nd</sup> Baptismal Service, Elizabeth (who was saved 29<sup>th</sup> June) was added to the Church. I have started preaching through Romans on Sunday Morning. We put up a basketball goal (in the area we cleared in September) for the kids to play after church, and they really enjoy it.

In November we were blessed with many visitors. Some we invited while on visitation, others came as our people invited them. Please pray for Taiatu, Viviani and their children, and Rico that they will see their need of Salvation and become regular in attendance. We were sad to see Joseph return to the AOG church after he'd been coming to services for several months. We wrapped up our End Times Bible Study series and started going through our church Constitution and Bylaws in preparation for our organization service sometime next year. Titus, our youngest, turned 1 on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of November, and we look forward to a

big 1<sup>st</sup> Birthday celebration, which is a Nauruan custom, when my parents get here early in December.
