We trust this letter finds you well and excited about serving the Lord in the New Year. The Lord continues to add His blessings to the work in Nauru. In December we had a Sunday average of 30.75 with 2 first time visitors, and an average of 5 for Bible Study. In January we had a Sunday average of 24.6 with 9 first time visitors, and an average of 5.25 for Bible Study.

In December my Mum and Dad came for their 2nd visit to Nauru. During their time here we celebrated Titus's first birthday with the roasting of a pig and many gifts from our church family and friends. My dad taught a two week Bible Study on Ruth. We had our children's Christmas program at church where the kids sang and recited verses from the Christmas Story. The last Christmas Day I spent with my parents was 10 years ago, before I went off to Bible College. This was their first Christmas with their grandsons and daughter-in-law. Dad and I stayed busy by adding a carport, doing some concrete work around the house and church area, and constructing a table tennis table.

December and January is our summer holiday here before school starts back up again for the new year. We are more than ready for school to be back in session so that all of our kids and adults will get back on a normal work/school schedule and not be distracted from the things of the Lord by Christmas parties, and family gatherings. Please continue to pray for the faithfulness and spiritual growth of our people.

Please pray for Michael and Girleena. They are a young married couple who started coming in January and have not missed since. They both come from church backgrounds, and show an interest in studying the Bible and we hope that in time we will be able to help meet their spiritual needs, whatever they might be.

We had our first Teen Time activity in January and had 8 teens come. We had a Bible devotion, ate some snacks and played table tennis and other games. Some are allowed to come to a Teen Time whose religious parents would not allow them to come to a Baptist Church service.
