Dear Praying Friends,

We Praise the Lord as He continues to build the International Baptist Church of Nauru. In June we averaged 53.5 on Sunday, and we had 15 first time visitors. We also averaged 10.75 for Bible Study, and had 3 saved and 4 baptized. In July we averaged 42.6 on Sunday with 2 first time visitors and 1 saved. We also had 18 and 11 at Teen Time for the two months.

The first Sunday in June was the "Send-off Sunday" for Pastor and Mrs. Wood. Pastor Wood's message about Palm Tree Christians from Psalm 92:12 was a great blessing to us and our people. Merhonda, Janine, Rocky and Rhondo were baptized and added as charter members. The church authorized Pastor Wood to do the baptizing, and he noted that this was his first time to baptize in the Pacific Ocean. Their trip to Nauru was a great blessing to our church family as well as our own family. We are thankful they were able to make the long trip to Nauru.

Since the attendances at our special meetings were good, we decided to start Sunday evening services. We started this service on the 19th of June and averaged 27.8 for June and July. The last Sunday in July we had dinner on the grounds and an afternoon service before taking everyone home. Please Pray for the faithfulness of our people to all church services.

Bro. Junior, who I mentioned in the last letter, preached twice in July. The first was planned for a Sunday evening, but the second one was quite unexpected when the following Sunday Morning I had no voice to Preach or lead singing. It was a blessing to have a faithful man able to fill in for me, and he did a great job both times he preached. We trust that the Lord will continue to use him and his wife and family in the ministry of our church.

Thank you to those who have been praying for Joseph and Bukaewe. I was blessed to be able to lead Joseph to the Lord the 20th of June and Christie helped Bukaewe get saved the 24th of July. They both started coming around April/May 2009, and have been on and off since then. We are thankful that through the preaching of the Word of God the Holy Spirit did His work in their hearts, and showed them their sinful and lost condition and need of a Saviour. Also saved in June were Ebony and Ebor, who are daughters of one of our members, Rarube. They have been coming on and off for some time, but have been more faithful recently and had raised their hands in the invitation to show they were unsure about being saved. Christie was able to go by on the 22nd of June and lead them both to the Lord. Please pray for these and their continued spiritual growth and understanding of Salvation and the Scriptures.
